### Youth Policy

In order to ensure the safety of our children and encourage attendance in our educational programs, it is the shul's policy that all children must either be in the Shabbat Groups Program or supervised in shul by their parents. Children ages 5 and under can only leave Shabbat groups when accompanied by a parent. Older children participating in Shabbat Groups may only leave once their group has ended. After shul is over, children playing on the playground must be supervised by their parents. Thank you for your cooperation in this process.

# COMMUNITY NEWS

The Jewish Family Services Food Pantry gives families hope and sustenance. With locations in Overland Park, KS and Kansas City, MO, The Pantry is the community's response to the growing need for food assistance in greater Kansas City. Since opening in the Fall of 2012, the struggle against hunger and food insecurity continues to grow. Since 2012 we have more than doubled the number of families served each month to nearly 390 families. **We always need shelf-stable food like canned and boxed goods, as well as personal care items and paper products.
